

Going Beyond Travel trip itinerary for Fishing Has No Boundaries in Oshkosh May 17-18, 2008

Saturday, May 17 – We need to get up early to catch the big ones...so pick ups will begin **at 6:00 AM!** There will be muffins, fruit, juice and coffee available on the bus. We will meet our fishing guides at Menominee Park at the Kiwanis Shelter on Lake Winnebago, in Oshkosh for a day of fishing. We plan to be in the boats, out on the lake, around 9 AM.

The boats will come in for lunch and a rest period where hotdogs, beans, chips and drinks will be served. Fishing resumes for the afternoon.

After all the fish are weighed, measured and cleaned a spaghetti dinner will be provided along with some entertainment and awards for fish caught.

We retire for the evening to the **Fairfield Inn (920- 233-8504)** where there is an **indoor pool** and **whirlpool**.

Sunday, May 18- There is an extended continental breakfast available at the hotel and a hot breakfast waiting for us at Menominee Park. A short devotion will be held at 8:30 AM. Then it is onto the boats again to try to catch more and bigger fish!

All the boats need to be back at the docks by 11:45 AM and the fish measured and weighed. While we eat a lunch of hamburgers, fruit, chips and drink there will be announcements and medals for all the lucky "fisherpeople!" We will collect our fish and other belongings and **return to Milwaukee by 3 PM.**

*Bring a **lifejacket and a fishing pole if you have one.** Bait will be provided. There are no guarantees on the weather. Please remember if it is windy it will be much cooler on the lake, if sunny and calm, it will be much warmer on the lake. Please dress in layers and bring a rain jacket along if rain may be predicted and sun screen if it is suppose to be sunny. (Usually FHNB provides all the "fishers" with a cap/hat) It is a good idea to label your lifejackets, fishing poles, jackets/sweatshirts and sunscreen.*
