

**Going Beyond Travel Trip Itinerary
For Sunny Myrtle Beach
September 15 – 19, 2009**

Tuesday, September 15 - We will be **meeting at 5:30 AM at Mitchell International Airport by the US Airways ticket area. Going Beyond Travel staff will be waiting/watching for you around the US Airways desk beginning at 5:15 AM.** We leave on flight 3556 at 7:05 AM. We arrive at Myrtle Beach at 12:15 PM. *Please make sure you have a valid, US government issued picture ID. (A Wisconsin State ID is best).*

Upon arrival in Myrtle Beach we will take a shuttle to our hotel, right on the ocean! We will be staying at the Monterey Bay suites. Each unit has 2 rooms a kitchen and private balcony. There are both indoor and outdoor pools and a lazy river. Only a few steps take you to the boardwalk or down to the sandy beach. There is a full, hot breakfast every morning at our hotel.

Over the next several days we will be able to dig in the sand, run in the waves, relax in the pool, stroll along the boardwalk, shop at the various stores, enjoy wonderful restaurants and live shows.

We will see Calvin Gilmore's **Carolina Opry** on Wednesday evening. This 2-hour award winning variety show that includes music, comedy and dance will have you singing all night long. Friday night we will go back to the magical songs of the 70's, 80's and 90's at the **Good Vibrations** show.

There will be options for you to do additional activities (at your cost) such as parasailing, renting a kayak, taking a banana boat ride, playing mini-golf, trying your luck at the SunCruz Casino, riding some rides at the Amusement Park or taking a fishing charter.

Saturday, September 19- We depart Myrtle Beach on US Airways flight 2208 at 6 PM, transfer to flight 3659 in Charlotte and **return to Milwaukee at 8:55 PM. Please have family/staff meet at the baggage area around 9 PM.**

It is recommended you carry as little as needed with you as a carry-on. All carry-on bags will be subjected to X-ray inspection. Remember any liquids, gels, and/or aerosols have to be 3 oz or less and labeled and in a clear, resealable quart sized bag. The average temperature in the Myrtle Beach area is around 80, but much cooler in the evenings. Please remember sunscreen, maybe a hat, beach towel, maybe an extra water bottle to use at the beach, and a light jacket for the evenings.
