Please call/email if you have a trip you'd like to put together for a small group.

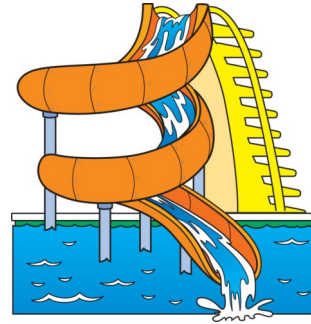
